Private Investigator Explains How To Tell If Your Partner Is Cheating

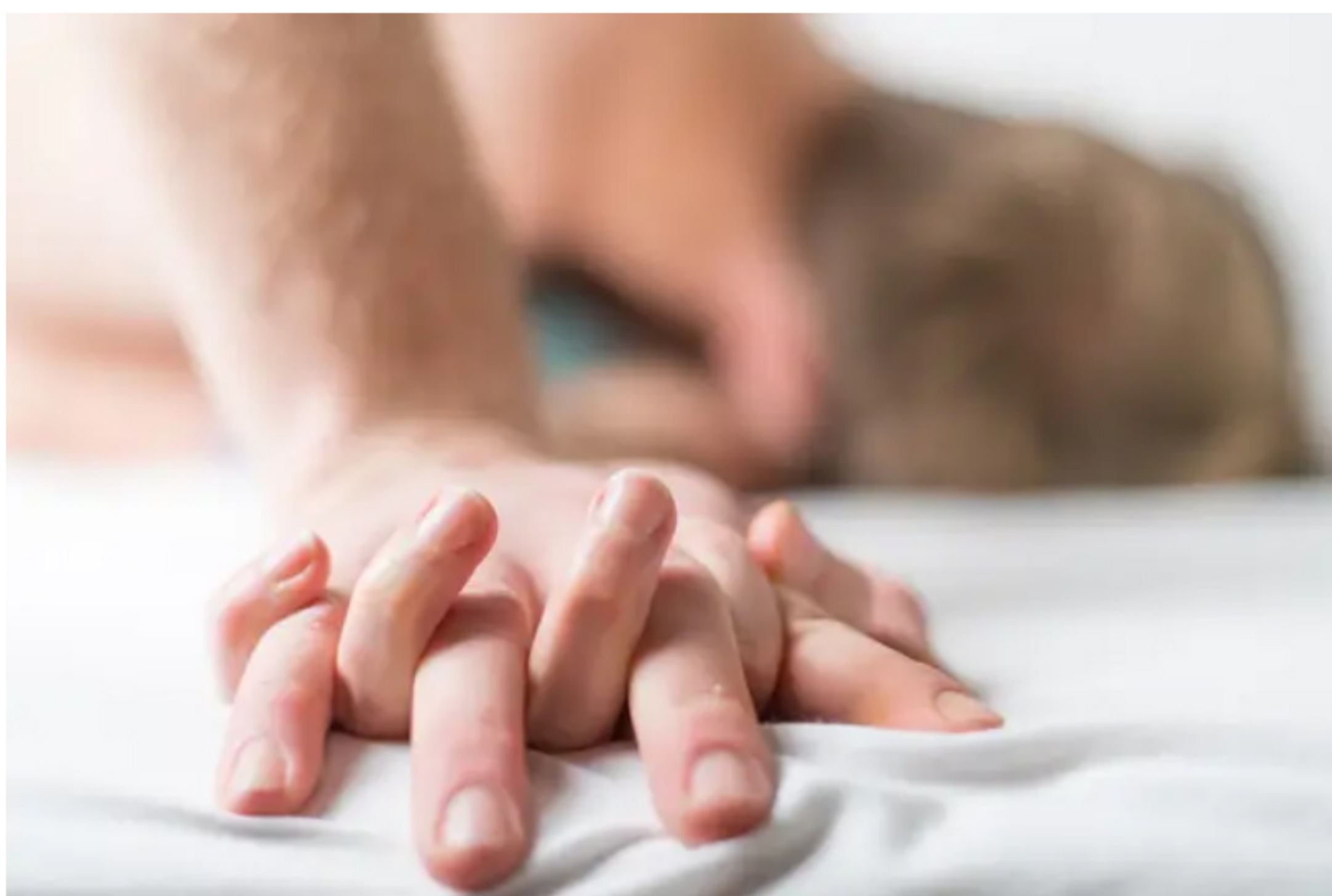
Discovering that your **partner** is cheating on you can be one of the most painful experiences imaginable.

But after more than four decades of delving into people's private lives and infidelity, a former **federal agent** has put together a list of red flags people should look out for if they're concerned their other half is playing away.

Tom Martin runs Martin Investigative Services in Newport Beach, California, and says there are 20 clues that could help you spot a love rat.

Now, while one or two of them, whether it's changing habits or business trips, shouldn't ring any alarm bells, if you start to notice four or more, then it's time to start asking questions.

"If you have three or four, you have a problem," he told the **Independent**.

He also explained that developments in technology have drastically changed the way in which people cheat on their partners.

"The game has changed drastically," he said. "And technology is 100 percent the reason why."

The full list of clues is as follows:

1. Changing habits
2. Leaving home early and returning late
3. Business trips
4. Absences during holidays or family events
5. Excessive overtime
6. Unexplained spending
7. Secret accounts (e.g. Instagram, email, etc.)
8. Hidden credit card bills
9. Extra grooming
10. Scent of someone else (also lipstick on the collar)
11. Buying gifts you haven't seen
12. Unexplained items (such as condoms in the car)
13. Joining a gym
14. Missed calls from an unknown number
15. Coded or secretive text messages
16. Less sex
17. Evasiveness or defensiveness
18. Obvious lies
19. Prickliness or short temper
20. Hates surprise visits (your unexpected arrival may come at an awkward moment for a cheater)

Sometimes, however, not much investigative work is actually needed to uncover a cheater.

Take Deyvi Andrade, for example, who was **caught smooching with another woman** on the big screen at a **football friendly** between Barcelona de Guayaquil and Delfin in Ecuador last year.

A video of their painfully awkward snog on the 'kiss cam' at the match between Barcelona SC and Delfin was watched millions of times on Twitter.

His sheepish demeanor in the clip led many viewers to think Deyvi may have not wanted to be seen kissing the mystery woman for a reason.

And it turns out they were right.
